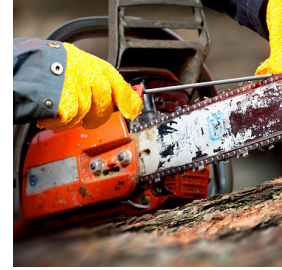

## Chain Saw Safety (T-600)



### Program Overview

This program is intended to give operators the basic knowledge and skills required to operate a chain saw safely. The program is designed with the principles described in the forest professional handbook.

### Training Objectives

Upon completion of the program students will be able to:

- Complete site hazard assessments
- Identify the required PPE for chainsaw operation
- Demonstrate safe starting techniques
- Demonstrate theoretical knowledge of falling and limbing
- Demonstrate basic knowledge of filing and maintenance

### Program Content

- Regulations review
- Personnel Protective Equipment
- Hazard assessment
- Bucking
- Knotching
- Limbing
- Basic Filing and maintenance

### Format

The program is a combination of theory and practical exercises. Students are evaluated by means of a written examination. A certificate of completion will be issued which aids in addressing the various legislative requirements placed upon employers to ensure their employees are competent. This program can be modified to meet the operator's specific needs.

### Duration

6 hours (may vary with class size and experience)

### PPE Required

- Hard hat with visor
- Safety glasses
- Safety boots (chainsaw cut resistant required in NB)
- Chainsaw cut resistant pants or chaps
- Hearing protection

### Location
