Confined Space Entrant/Attendant Training (CSEA)



Program Overview

This program will provide students with the fundamental knowledge of how to enter and work in and around confined spaces safely while adhering to legislative requirements and the best practices of industry.

Training Objectives

Upon completion of the program students will be able to:

- Identify a Confined Space
- Understand legislative requirements necessary to work in a Confined Space
- Recognize and control realized and potential Confined Space hazards
- Be familiar with the duties of the employer, employee, supervisor, entrant and attendant regarding work in Confined

Spaces

- Understand and complete Entry Programs and Entry Permit Systems
- Be familiar with proper gas detection techniques and atmospheric hazards
- Be familiar with methods of ventilation
- Be familiar with methods of proper Lockout/Tagout techniques
- Recognize the importance of establishing a proper Confined Space Emergency/Rescue Plan

Program Content

- Classroom lecture and demonstrations
- Confined Space Regulatory requirements
- Written procedures and hazard assessments
- Physical Hazards and Control Measures
- Atmospheric Hazards and Control Measures
- Confined Space Permit System
- Atmospheric gas detection principles
- Duties of Supervisors, Entrants, and Attendants
- Confined Space Emergency/Rescue Plan

Format

The program is predominantly classroom based training with practical examples of equipment and techniques. Students are evaluated by means of a written examination. A certificate of completion will be issued which aids in addressing the various legal requirements placed upon employers to ensure their employees are competent to work in and around Confined Spaces.

Certification Duration

Training is valid for two (2) years as per Provincial Legislation Requirements.

Program Duration

Six (6) to eight (8) hours. This may vary based on class size and number of companies within the class.

Location
